VI. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

1. Good News and Progress in our Schools

Dr. Lishak recognized the students from Franklin, Riley, Kennedy, Roosevelt, Grant and the Middle School for participating in the 2017 Spring School Food Drive. Our district collected a total of 4,000 pounds of food. She said that she is very proud of our students.

The Humanitarian Project, along with the Social Justice Club, put together an informative slide show about the current refugee crisis and the Syrian Civil War.

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It includes a number of games, short video clips and activities to help students understand what is happening in the world today. They did a great job and it will be shown at the high school.

In addition, our District Arts Festival will be held on May 19th here at the High School from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. It is going to showcase the talents of all of our students, grade K-12. This is the first time QR code scans are going to be used so that students can learn about the artwork from various student writings.

AP testing schedule is May 1st-12th, NJ Ask Science is May 31st, Biology exam is May 31st-June 1st and DLMS are ongoing now through May 11th.

Franklin School celebrated the kindergarten Grandparents Morning with breakfast and a brief show. They held a Mother's Day plant and flower sale, as well as a pre-k Mother's Day Tea. Our third graders from Franklin enjoyed a trip to Medieval Times and currently, Franklin is holding a school-wide book sale to encourage reading.

Kennedy School has had a very busy month with the PTSO-sponsored school-wide events and more coming up in May. The events include a mother/son dance on Friday, May 19th. Students and staff participated in the Chipotle restaurant fundraiser. It was very successful and a lot of fun for the students and staff. The Kennedy School spring concert will be held Tuesday, May 16th at 7:00 p.m. We invite all of the members of the Board of Education and central office to enjoy this wonderful event. Also, on June 2nd, the staff will be participating in an annual Kennedy School Variety Show.

Roosevelt School will hold their PTO Hawaiian theme family dance on Friday, May 19th. The Spring Concert will be held on Tuesday, May 23rd at 10:00 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. Field Day will be held on Wednesday, May 24th.

Grant School musical, "Singing in the Rain", was performed both yesterday evening and this morning for staff and students. The Endangered Species Awareness Week Penny Wars raised \$4,041 for the World Wildlife Fund. The Peer Leaders will hold fundraisers for the American Cancer Society during the week of May 15th. The 5th grade orientation will begin at the end of the month. The fourth graders will visit Grant School. The guidance counselor will conduct the orientation and the Student Council Executive Board will also assist.

There are a number of events at South Plainfield High School that you may want to mark into your calendars. AP Testing will be held from the 1st to the 12th. There will be a blood drive on May 23rd. Cultural Heritage Day will be held on May 24th. The High School spring concert will be held May 25th at 7:00 p.m. The end of year biology exam will be held on May 31st. The Hall of Fame Luncheon and

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Senior Awards will be held on June 5th at 6:30 p.m. The athletic booster awards dinner will be held on June 8th.

Congratulations to all of the Edison Rotary Seniors of the Month and to James Joyner who received the Edison Rotary of the Year scholarship award.

There are so many things to talk about in athletics. Baseball earned the 4th seed in the GMC county tournament and will play on Monday, May 15th at home. The Tiger baseball team is currently 13-7 and will start the NJSIAA State Tournament the week of May 22nd. The Boys track team is currently 4-0, vying for the blue ribbon division title. They've already secured the blue ribbon relay title. The girls' track team is currently 3-1 in their division and they've already won the blue division relay title. The golf team is currently 9-3 and will begin the GMC tournament on May 11th and the NJSIAA State Tournament on May 16th. The boys tennis team qualified for the NJSIAA State Tournament for the first time in a decade and are currently 6-6. The Lady Tigers softball team is currently 18-1 and ranked 13 in the State of New Jersey. They've earned the top seed in the GMC tournament and will play their first game on Saturday, May 13th, here at South Plainfield, weather permitting. The State Tournament will also be starting the week of May 22nd. The Lady Tigers lacrosse team recently celebrated their Senior Day with a win against JP Stevens. They earned a 6th seed in the GMC tournament. Congratulations to all of our student athletes.

IX. CURRICULUM/STUDENT ACTIVITIES

Curriculum Update - Administration

DISCUSSION

Ms. Malyska thanked all of the district teachers and administrators who volunteered to be a part of our various committees, specifically, the DEAC Committee, the District Evaluation Advisory Committee as well as the Curriculum Council. With their effort, it was really nice to see everyone's vested interest in putting forward new courses for the district, as well as reflecting on the evaluation practices that we've had in district along with the district assessment calendar. Their input has really pushed us forward in a great direction, so thank you to everyone that did that.

X. FINANCE

Finance Update – Administration

DISCUSSION

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Mr. Damato said that everything is going well with the accounting system conversion. Everything in the new budget is entered and we will be opening that up to the schools shortly. We will be going ahead with a temporary note sale for the paving projects that are part of the bond. We are working with our financial advisor and bond attorney to come up with the best possible interest rate for these notes. That will give us the opportunity to hopefully get those jobs to bid and completed before the start of school.

XI. BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS

Buildings & Grounds Update - Administration

DISCUSSION

Mr. Damato said that we are doing some boiler repairs this summer. Mr. Wiggins is working hard to have that completed before the fall. We are planning to do the Middle School gym floor replacement this summer. There will be no activities permitted at the Middle School this summer and until further notice. We are putting out a multitude of bids on different projects this summer, the most noteworthy one being the paving bids. You can hopefully expect to see that work being done this summer. We did get a new scoreboard that was provided by a generous grant from Investor's Savings and the South Plainfield Athletic Booster Association. The first new scoreboard to be installed will be at Jost Field for the football field. That will all be installed and ready to go for the football season in the fall.

XII. PRESENTATION OF COMMITTEE REPORTS

Buildings & Grounds

Mr. Giannakis said that with this referendum that passed and the amount of work that's getting done, he has not felt this confident in our leadership in a long, long time. He thanked Mr. Wiggins and Mr. Damato for their experience, their knowledge and everything they bring, as well as, for the confidence that they give him.

Mr. Seesselberg said, in addition to that, there are some projects that will be done outside of the referendum but we were able to finish them this year due to certain air conditioning projects and other things that will help the district.

Curriculum/Student Activities

Mr. Farinella said there was a discussion about the eighth grade counseling team training and using Naviance going into next year, which will benefit and effectively transition our eighth graders into our High School. There is an in-service training on May 12th in the district and there are some dual-credit opportunities that have been enhanced. World Language is primarily in the high school for our kids going into next year.

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Policy

Mrs. Miller said that the policy committee met and reviewed a couple policies. One is policy 8110, attendance areas. There will be revisions to address resident employees and the schools that their children are assigned to. If this does take place, the resident employee will have to agree to certain things that will be done within the policy. There will be a form that they will have to sign.

The other policy that was addressed was Policy and Regulation 5111, Eligibility of Resident and Non-resident students. The section that they will be revising will be children of non-resident Board of Education employees of three or more years may be admitted to attend school in the district, tuition will be charged. There will be a hierarchy that will be put into the policy and again, a district form will have to be signed so that everybody is aware of what will happen.

Shared Services

Mrs. Boyle said that she is working with Rob Bengivenga to come up with some meeting dates. Mr. Bengivenga is the council liaison and Tom Cassio and Sharon Miller are part of the committee.

Dr. Lishak mentioned the addition to the SRO contract is in the Board packet and it will be added to the agenda for next week.

SEPAC Liaison

Mr. Chapman said that he attended the SEPAC meeting last night. Unfortunately, they had a great speaker that was scheduled but she couldn't make it. It was nice to sit and talk with the people that were there. They've had some changes in the SEPAC. Mrs. Cochrane resigned and two new people stepped in as co-chairs. It was expressed very nicely that they would really like to have a better working relationship with the district and with the Board and really have more involvement. Mr. Giannakis was there as well and both of them think it is a very important organization and they encourage them to reach out to the Board more than they are right now and to let the Board know more in advance when their meetings are because they want to be involved. It was a very productive evening spent with them, despite the fact that their speaker couldn't make it.

Legislative Liaison

Mrs. Boyle said that they are trying to work on the budget with the Governor. There is still discussion going back and forth on the School Funding Reform Act. They're not coming to an agreement. They're working on calculations. There is still disagreement about whether or not PARCC should be made a graduation requirement. This is going back and forth between the Governor and New Jersey School Board's executive directors.

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There was a bill to allow for retroactive reimbursement for lead testing to the beginning of 2016. The bill is waiting for the governor.

Homeless Student Tuition - The Governor signed a bill which requires the state to pay the educational costs of a student who resides for more than one year in a homeless shelter located outside the student's district of residence.

A bill was signed that requires school districts to adopt a policy allowing students who participate in any school-sponsored, interscholastic extracurricular activity, such as robotics, to be eligible to earn a varsity letter awarded by the district.

Part of the County meeting was advocacy and we had Assemblywoman Pinkin and Assemblyman Karabinchak talk about their support for School Boards and for the Boards of Education. They asked that districts reach out to them and let them know when there is a problem. Mrs. Boyle said that she gave them both a copy of some of the bills that are waiting to be signed by the Governor.

Mrs. Boyle congratulated Chere Glover who received her Certified New Board Member certificate, which is a great feat. A lot of time is spent going to the seminars, conventions and different credit accommodations for the different program for education.

Mrs. Boyle congratulated Sharon Miller who was elected Vice President/Secretary for the Middlesex County School Board Association.

Mrs. Miller congratulated Mrs. Boyle for being elected President for the Middlesex County School Boards Association.

Mrs. Miller said that Assemblywoman Nancy Pinkin spoke about the school funding formula and the necessity to properly fund it. The governor wants to use casino money toward helping with drug addiction. Education and seniors will lose some of this money. There was a discussion among all the members there. Some of the other things that were discussed were teachers having to wait 184 days of one school year after retiring until they can substitute. Someone else brought up if someone loses a certification to teach in a public school they should not be allowed to teach in public colleges. PARCC as a graduation requirement was discussed. Also, Dan Harris, the Legislative Director to Assemblyman Craig Coughlin, is trying to get results of the bracketing study. Also discussed was public employee healthcare changes and the savings it would have for school districts. On February 28th the Governor proposed fiscal year 2018 budget with no real changes to school funding. He pledged to work with legislative leaders to develop a new formula. He put a 100 day deadline on the offer. Senator President Sweeney wants to revisit the school funding format. He reiterated this on May 2nd and indicated that a budget that doesn't start to address the unfairness in this funding formula will not pass the Senate. NJSBA said that any proposal that cuts funds from the original fiscal year 2018 proposed state figures could be a problem at this late date and any changes should be

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reflected in the fiscal year 2019 budget. They also gave us a reminder that the superintendent evaluations have to be done.

XIII. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Denise Hogan, teacher at the Middle School and association representative for the SPEA said that she has been in education for 46 years. She said she knows quality education and she knows kids. She is there to talk about something that is affecting the staff and the students at the Middle School. She said that she is going to remind the Board that the first job of any administration is to create an environment in which the teachers can teach and the kids can learn. Certainly, that involves materials, books but even more basic is an environment that is free from violence and physical harm. In the past few days, a critical change has occurred. No names are going to be used. A new student with very special needs.

Mr. Roselle interjected to make sure that we are all aware that any kind of details about the student should be kept confidential. So if we are going to talk about a specific student, please be aware of what you are saying so that it is not an identifiable student.

Many things have been observed. Paraprofessionals are being violently attacked. They are being harmed. Their hair is being pulled violently. In one instance, the para had to go to the hospital with whiplash because her ponytail was pulled so hard. The vice principal's hair was pulled where weaves were pulled out of her head. Teachers and paras are being scratched where blood is being drawn. Another para had to go get a tetanus shot. We have had three people go to the hospital already. The child was seen to have grabbed a para around the neck with both hands. He's frequently scratching and clawing at paraprofessionals, teachers and administrators to the point of leaving physical marks and drawing blood. He has been lunging toward staff in a threatening manner, almost knocking the principal into the pond. There is repetitive pant wetting and soiling.

Mr. Roselle said to Ms. Hogan that he understands where she is going with this but the longer we go on about what is happening with a specific student and who has paraprofessionals, that he is a little concerned that we can identify the student and he doesn't want that to be made public.

Mrs. Hogan said maybe she can get on with what her concerns are with this.

Mr. Roselle said that is fair but he would also like to say that if this is about a student, that is an administrative issue that she should take up with the Superintendent. There should be a meeting with the Superintendent to discuss this issue. The Board cannot comment and really has no control over a student issue.

Mrs. Hogan said that nothing is being done. There is a board referendum or amendment addressing this but nothing is being done about it. When the violence has been occurring,

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she said that she is to assume that their policy is to remove this student for a set amount of time to see what can be done but the student is not being removed and more and more people are being harmed.

Mr. Roselle said that he understands and he understands what she is saying but, again, that is an issue about a specific student's education. Those concerns should be brought to the Superintendent's office, who will then make the decision about what to do with the student. The Board doesn't have the ability to do anything at this point. It's an administrative issue about a specific student's education. Mr. Roselle said that he is hearing her concerns and he thanks her for bringing them to the Board and to the public and to the administration but this is really an issue that should be brought directly to the Superintendent.

Mrs. Hogan said that she is assuming that it has been brought to her. There are people there every day but every day it just gets worse and it's affecting the entire school.

Dr. Lishak said that she is aware of the situation. She is informed daily and she has discussions daily. She said she will not discuss it in public. She is in discussions with administration, the Director of Special Services, the Supervisor of Special Services but she will not have any conversation about it there.

Diana Joffe, SPEA President, said that she does believe that, as a citizen, a teacher is allowed to come up here and voice their concerns about things that are going on in the school so it's not that it has to go just to the administrator. She said she thinks that when there is an issue of this importance where the safety and well-being of the students and the staff is at hand that a teacher or anybody else has the right to come up and address the Board.

On another note, Mrs. Joffe said that she wanted to ask Mr. Chapman and Mr. Giannakis, through the chair, about SEPAC. She is a high school special education teacher so she always wondered if there's ever concerns if high school special education parents come to those meetings or what the issues are.

Mr. Chapman said that he doesn't go to every single one of them so he can't give an accurate answer on that. He said he doesn't know all the people in the room so he can't respond on that.

Mr. Giannakis said that he believes that highest grade level that there was a parent of was Middle School.

Mrs. Boyle said that she has been going to SEPAC since it was established and most of it is grammar school and Grant School and Middle School. She knows that Mr. Calman has always gone and his child has moved up to the high school level. There is one other person that attended whose child aged out.

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Mr. Giannakis said that they are trying to use Facebook to try to increase the amount of people that attend the meetings. They are trying to get more notices out and maybe create a calendar for the whole year and talk to the Superintendent about getting it on the school website.

Mrs. Joffe said that it is a shame because it is just as important for upper grade parents.

Mrs. Joffe asked Mrs. Miller if the policy about students of employees is being written now. Mrs. Miller said that we currently have a policy on that but it is being revised and it will be up for first reading next week. Mrs. Joffe asked if that includes children of teachers and administrators.

Mr. Miller said yes, for example, if you are a staff member at Kennedy school but you live in the Riley school area but you want your child to attend Kennedy school. It would affect those types of people.

Mrs. Joffe said, if you are a Kennedy School parent and you're a Riley school teacher and you want your kid to come to Riley and they are enrolled but another person moves in, that citizen can bump? And that would go for an administrator's child as well? Mrs. Miller said yes and it would apply to everyone.

Walter Calman, 112 Chambers Street, thanked Mr. Chapman and Mr. Giannakis for going to the SEPAC meeting last night. He thinks that the dialogue was very helpful to everybody there. We are going to try to do something to get more people to come out to the meetings so hopefully that will address some of those issues.

Mr. Calman said congratulations. This is the first meeting he was at for a couple of months so congratulations on the bond issue and all the hard work you guys did on that.

He said that one of the suggestions he made last night and he hopes that the Board will give serious consideration to is the hiring of the new Director for Special Services. He said that he has experience with doing this on the state level with state departments for divisions, directors and commissioners. It is helpful sometimes to have an advisory group that also meets with some of the candidates to give some perspective on the candidates. Ultimately, it is the decision of the administration, but sometimes that kind of input will be helpful, particularly in this area where there have been so many issue in the past years.

Dr. Lishak said that they have already done their first and second rounds. She took all of the concerns that were collected from the year. They're reviewed with the Special Services Action Committee. They had a lot to do with the questions that were given to the candidates. We are currently in the process of trying to secure one of the candidates for the position. So we do have somebody in mind, hopefully we can negotiate. She said she doesn't want you to think that we didn't take the concerns of the public. We spent an awful lot of time trying to make the special Services Department a better place and offer

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more communication. We did take a look at all of the things that came up during the year and then we framed our questions and had very long conversations and, in fact, one of the candidates in particular, asked about the relationship between our district and the parent group and how they would be involved in it. The candidate was also very interested in parent communication and transparency and all the things that we discussed and right now that is where we stand.

Mr. Calman said that he didn't know how far they were in the process but that is very helpful to know. Thank you very much.

XIV. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

Mrs. Boyle said that last night, the Junior Journalist Event, hosted by the South Plainfield Observer and Hometown Heroes, took place. There were 24 students who were honored. A full course dinner was offered to the students and their families. Mrs. Boyle thanked Mr. Bertram who is a Roosevelt School teacher who has such an amazing talent in bringing out the best in our students. She also thanked Mayor Anesh, Council President Derrick White and Councilman Joe Wolak for attending. She videotaped the event and it will be on the South Plainfield Observer website if anybody wants to view our students.

“Singing in the Rain”, the performance by the Grant School students was a spectacular show. They are always amazing. Thank you to Principal Ellen Decker-Lorys, Vice Principal Bobby Richkus and Joan Stasio and her staff who are part of this program and the students who gave their all. They were amazing.

May 23rd is the Middle School PTO Blood Drive, with the assistance of Student Council advisor, Tony Encinas, will be held here at the High School from 8:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. in the auditorium for anybody that is available to give blood.

Mrs. Boyle thanked Annmarie Stoeckel for hosting the parent academy on STEAM and STEM. She did a great job. It was very informative.

Hall of Fame candidates have been chosen and they will be honored on Monday, June 5th at the scholarship program in the evening.

Mrs. Boyle congratulated Dr. Lishak on her daughter's confirmation and wished blessings to all.

Mrs. Glover congratulated Debbie Boyle and Sharon Miller for being the President and Vice President of our county meetings which are very useful and very helpful. Mrs. Glover said that the legislators attend every meeting and you have their ear for a good hour. She said that it is a priceless event and encourages more board members to attend. All the topics are usually very interesting and applicable to what we do and it's nice to meet other board members from different towns in the county to hear what is going on

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elsewhere and get outside of the South Plainfield bubble. That's how you learn and grow.

Mr. Seesselberg said that he saw "Signing in the Rain" yesterday morning and that there are more people on stage and backstage than in the audience. It was a respectful audience. That show is tough to do on any type of semiprofessional/professional level and when you think the subject matter of the story, you have to explain to the kids what silent movies are, let alone black and white movies. The singing, acting and dancing was phenomenal. It was really a good show and they do a good job over there
